

1 Where can you find the answers?

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 NKJV

2 Should you worship God?

Worthy are You, our Lord and our God, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and because of Your will they existed, and were created. Revelation 4:11 NKJV

No one is good except God alone. Mark 10:18 NASB (Only God is good, so He is the only thing worth worshipping)

3 Does God like the praise of children? reword?

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not hinder them; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." Matthew 19:14 NIV

5 Why should you be careful speaking?

In the multitude of words sin is not lacking, but he who restrains his lips is wise. Proverbs 10:19 NKJV

6 How should you speak to others?

(Are they good? Are they helpful? Will they bless?)

Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. Ephesians 4:29 NKJV

7 Can words hurt?

There is one who speaks like the piercings of a sword, but the tongue of the wise promotes health. Proverbs 12:18 NKJV

1 Why should parents discipline their children?

Whoever spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is diligent to discipline him. Proverbs 13:24 ESV

2 What is the result of discipline?

For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it. Hebrews 12:11 ESV

3 When tempted to hate correction, remember . . .

Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge, but he who hates correction is stupid. Proverbs 12:1

5 Why should you listen to your parents?

(They will bring you many honors)

Hear, my son, your father's instruction, and forsake not your mother's teaching, for they are a graceful garland for your head and pendants for your neck. Proverbs 1:8-9 ESV

6 Why should you choose friendships wisely?

Do not be deceived: "Bad company ruins good morals." 1 Corinthians 15:33 ESV

He who walks with wise men will be wise, but the companion of fools will suffer harm. Proverbs 13:20 NASB

As iron sharpens iron, so a man sharpens the countenance of his friend. Proverbs 27:17 NKJV

7 What does God think of liars?

Lying lips are an abomination to the Lord, but those who deal truthfully are His delight. Proverbs 12:22 NKJV

1 Why should you take care of your body?

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? 1 Corinthians 3:16 NKJV

2 To whom should you be looking for an example? (Whom should you imitate?)

...fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:2 NASB

3 Should you be an example to others? In what ways?

Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity. 1 Timothy 4:12 NKJV

5 What should you do if someone is unkind to you?

Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. Luke 6:27-28 NASB

6 Should you fight and argue with people?

If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all. Romans 12:18 ESV

7 What is good and pleasant?

Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity! Psalm 133:1 ESV

1 How should you handle anger?

Let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God. James 1:19-20 ESV

2 What about when someone else is angry?

A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. Proverbs 15:1 NKJV

3 Why should you listen before you speak?

He who gives an answer before he hears, it is folly and shame to him. Proverbs 18:13 NASB

5 What should you guard above all else?

Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it. Proverbs 4:23 NIV

6 What is like a person that lacks self-control?

A man without self-control is like a city broken down, without walls. Proverbs 25:28

7 What is the beginning of strife compared to?

Starting a quarrel is like breaching a dam; so drop the matter before a dispute breaks out. Proverbs 17:14 NIV

1 If you need something will God provide it?

And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:19 NKJV

2 Will God give you good things?

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him! Matt. 7:11 NKJV

3 Where does your wealth come from? Should you be wasteful?

And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. Deuteronomy 8:18 NKJV

5 Should you respect authority (obey the law)?

Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God. Therefore whoever resists the authorities resists what God has appointed, and those who resist will incur judgment. Romans 13:1-2 ESV

6 What should you remember when bad things happen?

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose. Romans 8:28 NKJV

7 What is harder to win than a strong city?

A brother offended is harder to win than a strong city, and quarrels are like the bars of a castle. Proverbs 18:19 NKJV

1 How can you be truly happy?

He who heeds the word wisely will find good, and whoever trusts in the Lord, happy is he. Proverbs 16:20 NKJV

2 Can you trust God?

He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust. Psalm 91:2 NKJV

3 How does God feel about those who trust Him?

The Lord takes pleasure in those who fear Him, in those who hope in His mercy. Psalm 147:11 NKJV

5 How should you trust God?

*Trust in the Lord with all your heart,
And lean not on your own understanding;
In all your ways acknowledge Him,
And He shall direct your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6 NKJV*

6 What should you remember when you are afraid?

Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go. Joshua 1:9 NKJV

The name of the LORD is a strong tower, the righteous run to it and are safe.
Proverbs 18:10

(Jesus said) "I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Matthew 28:20
NASB

(God said) "I will never leave you nor forsake you." Hebrew 13:5 NKJV

7 Should you fear death?

Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his saints. Psalm 116:15 KJV

1 Does God hear your prayers?

*The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous,
And His ears are open to their cry. Psalms 34:15-18 NKJV*

2 Does prayer work?

The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. James 5:16 NKJV

3 When should we pray? What should we give thanks for? Why?

Pray without ceasing; in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:17-18 KJV

5 What should you think about?

Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. Philippians 4:8 NKJV

6 What should you hate?

To fear the Lord is to hate evil; I hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech. Proverbs 8:13 NIV

7 Who is like a dog returning to his vomit?

Like a dog that returns to his vomit is a fool who repeats his folly. Proverbs 26:11

1 Should you take revenge? Then what should you do?

Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. On the contrary, repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing. 1 Peter 3:9 NIV

2 What covers all offenses? (When tempted to tattle)

Hatred stirs up strife, but love covers all offenses. Proverbs 10:12 ESV

3 Why should Christians love one another?

In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. 1 John 4:9-11 ESV

5 How should you forgive each other?

Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ forgave you. Ephesians 4:32 ESV

6 Can God use me if I am weak?

My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong. 2 Corinthians 12:9-10 NKJV

7 What kind of boy or girl is better than the mighty?

He who is slow to anger is better than the mighty, and he who rules his spirit than he who takes a city. Proverbs 16:32

1 Does God care about you?

Cast all your anxiety on him because He cares for you. 1 Peter 5:7

2 Who comforts us?

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God. 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 NKJV

3 Is God with you in trouble? What does God think of you?

*Fear not, for I have redeemed you;
I have called you by your name;
You are Mine.*

*When you pass through the waters, I will be with you;
And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you.
When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned,
Nor shall the flame scorch you.*

*For I am the Lord your God,
The Holy One of Israel, your Savior;
I gave Egypt for your ransom,
Ethiopia and Seba in your place.*

*Since you were precious in My sight,
You have been honored,
And I have loved you;
Therefore I will give men for you,
And people for your life.*

Fear not, for I am with you; Isaiah 43:1-5 NKJV

5 Why should you avoid aggravating others or picking on them?

*There are six things the Lord hates,
seven that are detestable to him:*

*haughty eyes,
a lying tongue,
hands that shed innocent blood,
a heart that devises wicked schemes,
feet that are quick to rush into evil,
a false witness who pours out lies*

and a person who stirs up conflict in the community. Proverbs 6:16-19 NIV

6 How can you get wisdom?

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. James 1:4-5 NKJV

7 Can you be wise without receiving instruction?

*Listen to counsel and accept discipline, that you may be wise the rest of your days.
Proverbs 19:20 ESV*

1 Can you resist temptation?

No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it. I Corinthians. 10:13 ESV

2 Can you do what God asks you to do?

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. Philippians 4:13 NKJV

3 Should you give up?

And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart. Galatians 6:9 NKJV

5 How should you work?

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters. Colossians 3:23 NIV

6 What's the opposite of diligence? What happens to the lazy? Which of God's creatures exemplify diligence?

Go to the ant, you sluggard! Consider her ways and be wise, which, having no captain, overseer or ruler, provides her supplies in the summer, and gathers her food in the harvest.

How long will you slumber, O sluggard? When will you rise from your sleep? A little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep—so shall your poverty come on you like a prowler, and your need like an armed man. Proverbs 6:6-11 NKJV

7 Are you rewarded for diligence?

Seest thou a man diligent in his business? He shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before obscure men. Proverbs 22:29 KJV

1 Who should you try to please with our words?

Let the words of my mouth, and the meditations of my heart be acceptable in Thy sight, O Lord, my strength and my Redeemer. Psalm 19:14 NKJV

2 What should you feel when people make fun of your love for Jesus?

Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you. Matthew 5:11-12 NKJV

3 Whose children can we be? If God is King, and you are his child, what does that make you?

But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. John 1:12-13 ESV

5 Should you worry? What should you do?

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 NKJV

6 What is our responsibility to each other?

And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works... Hebrews 10:24

7 What should you do without grumbling or complaining? Why?

Do all things without complaining and disputing, that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world. Philippians 2:14-15 NKJV

1 Why should you hide God's word in your heart?

*Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. Psalm 119:11
KJV*

2 Why should you not blame-shift? What does God promise if we confess?

*He who covers his sins will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes them will
have mercy. Proverbs 28:13 NKJV*

3 Will sin stay hidden?

*You have sinned against the Lord; and be sure your sin will find you out. Numbers
32:23 NKJV*

5 What should you think of others?

*Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more
significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also
to the interests of others. Philippians. 2:3-4 ESV*

*Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. Romans
12:10 NIV*

6 What if you only want to please yourself (be selfish)?

*Whatever one sows, that will he also reap. For the one who sows to his own flesh will
from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit
reap eternal life. Galatians 6:7-8 ESV*
